#### **Medical Information Updates**

Please understand that we will ask you to update your medical information with us, in writing, once per year. On other visits, we will verbally confirm your medical information. This is due to the fact that numerous medical conditions can have an effect on your oral health. Also, certain dental procedures may need to be modified depending on your past or current health conditions. Please bring a list of your medications to all appointments. Many medications, including some over the counter medications, supplements and vitamins, can have a negative effect on your dental health.



### First Aid for Dental Emergency

What should you do if a permanent tooth is knocked out? First find the tooth. Handle the tooth by the top, crown portion, not the root. Rinse the tooth off but do not scrub it. Try to reinsert the tooth into the socket. Hold the tooth with a gauze or cloth. If you cannot reinsert the tooth, transport the tooth in a cup containing milk or water. Apply pressure to the gum with gauze or paper towel to help control any bleeding. Call our office immediately. Time is a critical factor in saving the tooth.
